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DO DISTANCE OR TRAVELING TIME TO CENTRAL BUSINESS DISTRICT HAS EFFECT ON RESIDENTIAL LAND PRICE IN URBAN AREA?

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Abstract- This study was intended to reveal the effect of accessibility believed to exert an effect on land price, where the accessibility refers to the variable of distance and traveling time to city center or central business district (CBD). In this study, the accessibility was measured in terms of distance as well as travelling time from land location to CBD. Based on the multiple linear regression analysis results on 379 land samples, it was shown that distances to CBD did not exert significant influences, while the travelling time exert significant influences on the land prices. Travelling times to Gadjah Mada University campus and Malioboro area exerted significant influences on housing land prices. This result revealed, that the accessibility of traditional location theory is no longer measured from the distance to the city center, but the more significant travel time affects the price of residential land.
